3. DISCUSSION/DECISION REGARDING APPROVAL OF PSYCHOLOGY APPLICANTS

Requesting Approval to sit for Examination (EPPP) & Licensure

Angela Scott, Psy.D. – Committee members proceeded with a substantive review of Dr. Scott's reapplication. Upon review, the Committee noted that the materials submitted were complete and fulfilled the requirements of statutes and rules. It was the consensus of the Committee to move Dr. Scott's reapplication to the full Board for approval to take the EPPP.

Miguel Iracheta, Ph.D. – Committee members proceeded with a substantive review of Dr. Iracheta's reapplication. Upon review, the Committee noted that the materials submitted were

It was the consensus of the Committee to forward Dr. Usndek's application to the full Board for further review of his request to apply for licensure by credential.

Kerry Davis, Ph.D. – Committee members proceeded with a substantive review of Dr. Davis’ application. Upon review of her application, the Committee noted that her Certificate of Professional Qualification expired December 2015, otherwise the materials submitted were complete and fulfilled the requirements of statutes and rules. The Committee directed Board staff to verify whether Dr. Davis renewed her Certificate of Professional Qualification with the Association of State and Provincial Psychology Boards. It was the consensus of the Committee to move Dr. Davis’ application to the full Board for review and approval of licensure upon confirmation that she renewed her Certificate of Professional Qualification and it is in good standing.

Dr. Brundage made a motion, seconded by Dr. Wechsler, to forward the application of David Usndek, Psy.D., to the full Board for further review of his request to apply for licensure by credential and to forward the application of Kerry Davis, Ph.D., to the full Board for review and approval of licensure upon payment of the pro-rated licensure fee once confirmation is received by the Board office that her Certificate of Professional Qualification is current and in good standing. The motion carried 2-0.
