#### **1) CALL TO ORDER**

The regular session of the Arizona State Board of Psychologist Examiners Legislative Committee was called to order by Dr. Bohanske at 7:30 a.m. on November 16, 2018. No Executive Sessions were held.

#### **3) REVIEW, DISCUSSION AND CONSIDERATION OF UPCOMING LEGISLATIVE SESSION**

Ms. Jones provided a summary stating that the Psychological Clinical Science Accreditation System (PCSAS) presented legislation to the Board of Regents. The Committee discussed the legislation that PCSAS sponsored last legislative session. The Arizona Psychological Associations Legislative Representative, Phillip C. Barry, was present telephonically. The Committee requested that Ms. Jones monitor this legislation, set a meeting with Representative Barto and communicate with the Arizona Psychological Association regarding this legislation.

**4) REVIEW, DISCUSSION AND CONSIDERATION OF TIMING FOR LEGISLATION REGARDING FINGERPRINT CLEARANCE CARDS**

Ms. Jones provided a summary stating that the Board is currently undergoing its Sunset Audit. Ms. Jones indicated that the auditor's will likely make a recommendation that the Board require background checks for applicants. The Committee discussed the timing for running legislation. The Committee requested that Ms. Jones seek input from stakeholders.

**5) REVIEW, DISCUSSION AND CONSIDERATION OF FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS**

The Committee discussed holding another meeting in January. Committee members requested that the Association of State and Provincial Psychology Boards PLUS application be placed on the Board's agenda for an update. Committee members requested that an update pertaining to PSYPACT be placed on a future Board agenda.

There being no further business to come before the Committee, Dr. Brundage made a motion, seconded by Dr. Davey, to adjourn the meeting at 8:20 a.m. The motion carried 3-0.
