### **1. CALL TO ORDER**

The regular session of the Arizona Board of Psychologist Examiners Complaint Screening Committee was called to order by Madame Chair Shreeve at 8:31 a.m. on November 7, 2018. No Executive Sessions were held.

### **3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

- October 10, 2018, Regular Session Minutes

Dr. Brundage made a motion, seconded by Dr. Bohanske, to approve the October 10, 2018, Regular Session minutes as drafted. The motion carried 3-0.

### **4. CASE DISCUSSION/DECISION**

#### **a. Angela Chiodo, Psy.D., Complaint No. 18-12**

Dr. Bohanske summarized the case, including salient points of the investigation and pertinent records. The Complainant was not present. The Licensee and the Licensee's attorney, Faren

Akins, Esq., were present. The Licensee requested to speak, made a statement and answered Committee members' questions. After deliberation, Dr. Bohanske made a motion, seconded by Dr. Brundage, to dismiss this matter as there are no violations of rule or statute. The motion carried unanimously (3-0), by a voice vote.

**b. Melissa Estavillo, Psy.D. Complaint No. 18-19**

Ms. Shreeve summarized the case, including salient points of the investigation and pertinent records. The Complainant was not present. The Licensee and the Licensee's attorney, Jessica Miller, Esq., were present. Ms. Miller requested to speak and made a statement. After deliberation, Ms. Shreeve made a motion, seconded by Dr. Bohanske, to dismiss this matter as there are no violations of rule or statute. The motion carried unanimously (3-0), by a voice vote.

**c. Theodore Etling, Psy.D., Complaint No. 18-20**

Ms. Shreeve summarized the case, including salient points of the investigation and pertinent records. The Complainant was not present. The Licensee and the Licensee's attorney, Faren Akins, Esq., were present. The Licensee made a statement and answered Committee members' questions. After deliberation, Ms. Shreeve made a motion, seconded by Dr. Bohanske, to dismiss this matter as there are no violations of rule or statute. The motion carried unanimously (3-0), by a voice vote.

**d. Jon McCaine, Ph.D. Complaint No. 18-21**

Dr. Brundage summarized the case, including salient points of the investigation and pertinent records. The Complainant was not present. The Licensee was present, requested to speak, made a statement and answered Committee members' questions. After deliberation, Dr. Brundage made a motion, seconded by Dr. Bohanske, to forward Complaint No. 18-21 to the Board for possible violations of A.R.S. §32-2061(16)(h) for possibly failing or refusing to maintain and retain adequate business, financial or professional records pertaining to the psychological services provided to a client or patient; A.R.S. §32-2061(q) for possibly representing activities or services as being performed under the licensee's supervision if the psychologist has not assumed responsibility for them and has not exercised control, oversight and review and A.R.S. 32-2061(dd) for possibly violating an ethical standard adopted by the board as it pertains to the American Psychological Association Ethical Principles of Psychologist and Code of Conduct 7.01 Design of Education and Training Programs and 7.06 Assessing Student and Supervisee Performance. The motion carried unanimously (3-0), by a voice vote.

**e. Rodney Pearson, Complaint No. T-18-22 and T-18-23**

Dr. Bohanske recused from reviewing the Complaints and exited the meeting room. Dr. Brundage summarized the cases, including salient points of the investigation and pertinent records. Complaint No. T-18-23 was submitted anonymously and the Complainant for T-18-22 was not present. The Respondent was present, requested to speak, made a statement and answered Committee members' questions. After deliberation, Dr. Brundage made a motion, seconded by Ms. Shreeve, to dismiss this matter as there are no violations of rule or statute. The motion carried 2-0-1 by a voice vote with Dr. Bohanske recused.

**5. ADJOURN**

There being no further business to come before the Committee, Dr. Bohanske made a motion, seconded by Dr. Brundage, to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried (3-0) and the meeting was adjourned at 9:53 a.m.
