**1. CALL TO ORDER**

The regular session of the Arizona Board of Psychologist Examiners Complaint Screening Committee was called to order by Chairman Brundage at 9:01 a.m. on December 2, 2015.

**3. CASE DISCUSSION/DECISION**

**a. Celia Drake, Ph.D., RFI 15-42**

Dr. Brundage summarized the case, including salient points of the investigation and pertinent records. The Complainant was present telephonically and made a statement. Committee members had no questions for the Complainant. The Licensee was not present. After deliberation, Mr. Robichaud made a motion, seconded by Dr. Mellott to dismiss the complaint upon finding no violation of statute or rule. The motion carried unanimously (3-0), by a voice vote.

**b. William Arnett, Psy.D, RFI 15-31**

Mr. Robichaud summarized the case, including salient points of the investigation and pertinent records. The Board was the complainant in this matter. The Licensee was present. Licensee's attorney, Brett Rigg, was present telephonically. Licensee and Mr. Rigg made brief statements and answered Committee member questions. After deliberation, Dr. Brundage made a motion, seconded by Dr. Mellott, to forward the case to the full Board for further review and investigation for possible violations of A.R.S. §32-2061(15)(o), for possible provision of services that are unnecessary or unsafe, or otherwise engaging in activities as a psychologist that are unprofessional by current standards of practice; and A.R.S. §32-2061(15)(i), for possible commission of a felony, whether or not involving moral turpitude, or a misdemeanor involving moral turpitude. In either case, conviction by a court of competent jurisdiction or a plea of no contest is conclusive evidence of the commission. The motion carried unanimously (3-0), by a voice vote. The Committee also requested that the Licensee keep the Board apprised of developments related to his legal matter and provide the Board with any associated documentation.

**c. Glenn Moe, Ph.D., RFI 15-35**

Dr. Brundage summarized the case, including salient points of the investigation and pertinent records. The Complainant was present and made a brief statement. Committee members had no questions for the Complainant. The Licensee and his attorney, Charles Struble, were present and the Licensee made a brief statement. Committee members had no questions for the Licensee. After deliberation, Dr. Brundage made a motion, seconded by Dr. Mellott, to dismiss the complaint upon finding no violation of statute or rule. The motion carried unanimously (3-0), by a voice vote.

**d. Valerie Kemper, Psy.D., RFI 15-40**

Dr. Mellott summarized the case, including salient points of the investigation and pertinent records. Neither the Complainant nor the Licensee were present. After deliberation, Dr. Mellott made a motion, seconded by Mr. Robichaud, to dismiss the complaint upon finding no violation of statute or rule. The motion carried unanimously (3-0), by a voice vote.

**e. Valerie Kemper, Psy.D., RFI 15-41**

Dr. Mellott summarized the case, including salient points of the investigation and pertinent records. Neither the Complainant nor the Licensee were present. After deliberation, Dr. Mellott made a motion, seconded by Mr. Robichaud, to dismiss the complaint upon finding no violation of statute or rule. The motion carried unanimously (3-0), by a voice vote.

**4. ADJOURN**

There being no further business to come before the Committee, a motion to adjourn was made by Mr. Robichaud, seconded by Dr. Mellott, and unanimously carried 3-0. The meeting was adjourned at 10:31 a.m.
