

Increased Professional & Operating Costs Funding Priority: 1 Request: \$30,200

Overview of Funding Issue

A number of agency operating costs have either increased beginning in FY22, or are projected to increase in FY23. Most of the expenses are a function of the substantial increases in the number of licensees regulated. While most of the individual increases, in and of themselves, do not have a significant adverse impact to the agency's operating budget, the cumulative impact will strain its resources beginning July 1, 2022 such that difficult expense reductions will need to be executed, potentially hindering public protection in the process.

Background & Justification of Funding Issue

Since FY17, the agency has entered into an interagency service agreement (ISA) with the Office of the Attorney General for purposes of ensuring a dedicated Assistant Attorney General's legal services at the level of 0.13 of an FTE, or 204.88 hours per year. However, the actual hours logged by the AAG over the two most recent fiscal years were more were twice the amount the current ISA covers and are at the level of a 0.30 FTE:

2021	204.88	492.70	287.12

To close this gap and to adequately fund the actual level of legal services used by the agency, a modification to the FTE must be made to raise it from 0.13 FTE to a 0.30 FTE. This table illustrates this adjustment in terms of cost:

Solution to Funding Issue:

The agency requires an appropriation adjustment totaling \$30,200 in order to effectively address both the cost increases, as well as actual costs incurred, for professional and operating services.

Arizona State Board of Psychologist Examiners INTERAGENCY SERVICE AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made pursuant to A.R.S. § 35-148(A) between the Arizona State Board of Psychologist Examiners, ("PSY" or "Department"), and the OFFICE OF THE ARIZONA ATTORNEY GENERAL ("Attorney General").

RECITALS:

- 1. The Arizona State Board of Psychologist Examiners (PSY) under A.R.S. § 32-2063(B)(C), Powers and Duties is provided authority to execute contracts on behalf of PSY.
- 2. The Attorney General is authorized to approve long-range plans for developing programs and coordinating legal services required by state agencies pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-192(A)(3).
- 3. PSY has requested additional legal services from the Attorney General.
- 4. The Attorney General has determined that the funding provided here under is needed in order to provide the requested legal services.
- 5. Although it is the Attorney General's desire to provide additional legal services to the PSY, the Attorney General does not have the funds available to pay for the aforementioned attorneys and support staff.
- 6. PSY represents it has available monies which can be transferred to the Attorney General for use in paying for the additional staff and expenses related to representation of PSY and that PSY desires that such funds be used for that purpose. THEREFORE, PSY and the Attorney General agree as follows:
- A. The Attorney General will provide attorney services commensurate with the Annual Salaries, Employee Related Expenditures, and All Other Operating Expenditures including Indirect Employment Costs listed in paragraph C of this Agreement under the supervision of the Chief Counsel of the Licensing and Enforcement Section. The attorneys will render such legal services as may be necessary to represent and advise PSY including, but not limited to, litigation for and in defense of PSY. The Attorney General reserves the right to assign other duties or projects to the Assistant Attorney General assigned to provide legal services to PSY, whenever that can be done without having the effect of denying PSY the legal services that are the subject of this agreement. The Attorney General also may assign matters related to PSY to assistant attorneys general other than the Assistant Attorney General whose primary duties are to represent PSY.
- B. The Attorney General will employ one (1) Assistant Attorney General (.13 FTE) with funding provided by this Agreement, to be assigned to the State Government Division of the Office of the Attorney General under the supervision of the Chief Counsel of the Licensing and Enforcement Section. Any support staff funded through this ISA, will render such legal services as may be necessary to support attorneys representing PSY, including, but not limited to, litigation support for and in defense of PSY.
- C. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 35-148(A), payment for the attorneys and support staff funded by this ISA will be accomplished through the transfer of funds by PSY to the Attorney General in the following manner and covers the period of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022:
 - (1) PSY will transfer the following amount: Fiscal Year 2022 (rounded) \$21,100.

- (2) The amount set forth in paragraph 6(C)(1) will be distributed to the Office of the Attorney General as follows:
 - a. A payment of \$5,275 is due July 15, 2021.
 - b. The amount of \$5,275 is due October 15, 2021.
 - c. The amount of \$5,275 is due January 15, 2022.
 - d. The amount of \$5,275 is due April 15, 2022.
- (3) In addition to the foregoing amounts, PSY shall transfer an amount equal to any market adjustment, cost of living or performance increase authorized by the Legislature.
- (4) The Attorney General will review actual and projected expenditures at the end of the second and third quarters and submit to PSY adjusted billings for the third and fourth quarters, to reflect any savings if applicable. These identified savings will then be deducted from the amounts specified in (2)(c) and (d) above.
- D. It is the understanding of both parties to this Agreement that the dollar amount identified in the foregoing includes an estimated amount for Salaries, Employee Related Expenditures and All Other Operating Expenditures including Indirect Employment Costs. In the event that these costs are fairly determined to be more than the amount included in the dollar amount identified in the foregoing, the parties agree that the Arizona Attorney General's Office, in conjunction with PSY will adjust the total amount to be paid under this Agreement to reflect the true costs as reflected in the State Accounting system.
- E. PSY and the Attorney General agree that case-related expenses approved by PSY, such as consultants, expert witnesses, depositions, transcripts, travel or similar expenses will be paid by PSY. The Attorney General will consult with PSY as to the objectives of the representation, the means by which they are to be accomplished, and related costs. The Attorney General will determine the strategy, tactics, and technical issues related to the legal procedure, including the scope of discovery, consulting and expert witnesses, which witnesses to call, and the substance of direct and cross-examination. The Attorney General will determine any consultants and expert witnesses to be used, upon consultation with PSY regarding estimated costs.

PSY will pay all fees and costs expended for this matter. Those costs that are paid in advance will be paid in advance by PSY, including filing, service of process, and reproduction. PSY agrees to pay all fees and costs expended in this litigation that are not paid in advance, such as court costs, litigation expenses, consulting and witness fees (expert and otherwise), deposition expenses, transcription costs, telephone, and photocopying expenses, as said expenses are incurred.

- F. All funds received by the Attorney General from PSY under this Agreement shall be deposited into the AG ISA Fund and not used for any purpose other than those described herein. In the event this Agreement is terminated, funding for the positions will be provided through the end of the fiscal year in which the Agreement is terminated. Any transferred funds not used will be returned to PSY.
- G. The Attorney General shall provide office or work space and telephones for the attorneys and any support staff funded by this ISA. Payment for the space and telephones is included in the All Other Operating section of the budget.

- H. All decisions concerning the hiring, initial salary, supervision, awarding of promotions, market adjustment increases, performance increases or cost of living increases that may be for positions funded by this Agreement shall be the responsibility of the Attorney General in consultation with PSY.
- I. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-511, the State, its political subdivisions or any department or agency of either may, within three years after its execution, cancel any Agreement, without penalty or further obligation, made by the State, its political subdivisions, or any of the departments or agencies of either if any person significantly involved in initiating, negotiating, securing, drafting or creating the Agreement on behalf of the State, its political subdivisions or any of the departments or agencies of either is, at any time while the Agreement or any extension of the Agreement is in effect, an employee or agent of any other Party to the Agreement in any capacity or a consultant to any other Party of the Agreement with respect to the subject matter of the Agreement.
- J. Every payment obligation of the State under this Agreement is conditioned upon the availability of funds continuing to be appropriated or allocated for the payment of such obligation. If funds are not allocated and available for the continuance of the Agreement, this Agreement may be terminated by the State at the end of the period for which funds are available. No liability shall accrue to the State in the event this provision is exercised, and the State shall not be obligated or liable for any future payments or for any damages as a result of termination under this paragraph.
- K. The Parties to this Agreement agree to resolve all disputes arising out of or relating to this Agreement through arbitration, after exhausting applicable administrative review, to the extent required by A.R.S. § 12-1518, except as may be required by other applicable statutes.
- L. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 35-214, the parties shall retain and contractually require each subcontractor to retain all data, books and other records ("records") relating to this Agreement for a period of five years after completion of the Agreement. All records shall be subject to inspection and audit by the State at reasonable times. Upon request, the parties shall produce any or all such records.
- M. In accordance with A.R.S. § 41-1461, the Arizona Attorney General's Office shall provide equal employment opportunities for all persons, regardless of race, color, creed, religion, sex, age, national origin, disability or political affiliation. The Arizona Attorney General's Office shall comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act.
- N. This Agreement shall be governed, construed, and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Arizona.
- O. This agreement shall be effective upon execution by both parties and covers the period of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022. Any balance of funds advanced to the Attorney General pursuant to paragraph (C)(2) remaining on June 30, 2022 will be returned to PSY.
- P. On or before July 31, 2022, the Office of the Attorney General shall render to PSY an accounting for all funds expended by the Attorney General pursuant to this agreement
- Q. Each party shall have the right to terminate this Agreement in whole or in part, without cause by written notice effective thirty (30) days after mailing to the other party written notice of termination by certified mail return receipt requested. The termination shall be effective at the end of the 30 days. In the event that the monies required to be paid hereunder have been prepaid, a refund shall be provided on a pro rata basis determined by the time remaining from the effective date of the termination until the end of the prepaid

period. In the event that the monies required to be paid hereunder have not been prepaid, the agency shall pay those fees on a pro rata basis up to the effective date of the termination.

Increase 0.5 FTE to 0.75 FTE to Manage Applications Submitted to the Out-of-State Telehealth Registry – A.R.S. §36-3606 Funding Priority: 2 Request: \$19,960

Overview of Funding Issue

A funding increase to expand an existing position currently at a 0.5 FTE to a 0.75 FTE is required to support the newly added responsibilities associated with the intake, review, and processing of registrations to the Out-of-State Telehealth Practice Registry ("Registry") established by HB 2454 Telehealth; health care providers; requirements and chaptered at A.R.S. §36-3606 Interstate telehealth services; registration; requirements; venue; exceptions.

Background & Justification of Funding Issue

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, pursuant to A.R.S. §32-3124. Temporary licensure; rules; fee; applicability, from April 1, 2020 through August 20, 2021 the agency issued 617 temporary emergency licenses to out-of-state psychologists and behavior analysts, permitting them to deliver their services into Arizona through telehealth. The temporary emergency licenses are active until the date Governor Doug Ducey lifts the state of emergency he declared in response to the COVID pandemic. Once the emergency is lifted, many of the 617 temporary emergency license holders will likely need to continue providing psychological and behavior analytic services to their clients located in Arizona, and to do so will apply to the Registry for authorization to continue their practice and service delivery into this state.

The temporary emergency licenses require only minimal application requirements:

- A completed 1-page application (no fee)
- Copy of a government-issued identification document featuring a photograph
- Written verification of licensure in all other jurisdictions where licensure is held reflecting no unresolved complaints, or license suspensions or revocations
- The Board has delegated the responsibility to the Executive Director of approving temporary emergency licenses to qualified applicants

By contrast, the Registry establishes considerably more requirements for agency staff to process, and for the substantive review to be conducted:

- A completed application packet
- Payment of the Registry fee
- Evidence of professional liability insurance coverage to include coverage for telehealth services provided in Arizona
- Proof of designation of a duly appointed statutory agent for service of process in Arizona

- Verification of license to practice in other jurisdictions that is substantially similar to a license issued in Arizona to a comparable health care provider, and is not subject to any past or pending disciplinary proceedings in any jurisdiction
- Consent to Arizona's jurisdiction for any disciplinary action or legal proceeding related to the health care provider's acts or omissions
- An annual update to the registration
- An annual report with the number of patients served in Arizona and the total number and type of encounters in Arizona for the preceding year
- Preparation of the file and the annual updates to the Application Review Committee or the Committee on Behavior Analysts, and to the Arizona Board of Psychologist Examiners for substantive review and approval or denial

The Joint Legislative Budget Committee prepared a <u>fiscal note</u> for <u>HB 2454 Telehealth; health care</u> <u>providers; requirements</u>. The fiscal note states "We assume each Arizona regulatory board would set a fee sufficient to cover the costs associated with the registration and oversight of out-of-state providers. Some regulatory boards may require additional appropriations to utilize the fee revenue, but we cannot estimate this amount in advance." Without such an appropriation increase to sustain the cost of the additional required personnel:

- Registry applicants will experience delays in the processing, review, and issuance of their practice permissions
- Service delivery interruptions will leave patients and clients temporarily without critical behavioral and mental health services
- Investigations into unprofessional conduct on the part of Registrants will be slow to progress, presenting a risk to the health, safety, and welfare of the public.

Solution to Funding Issue:

The agency requires an additional 0.25 FTE and associated funding as outlined below to assume the responsibility of processing the Registry applications and for preparing them for substantive review by the Application Review Committee, the Committee on Behavior Analysts, and the Board.

The solution is to expand the existing 0.5 FTE position to a 0.75 FTE. This position is a Licensing Specialist who possesses the fundamental knowledge, skills and abilities to complete Registry application intake, and to process and prepare for substantive review the Registry applications.

HB 2454 Telehealth; health care providers; requirements included a provision that agencies implementing the Registry may execute an exempt rulemaking for purposes of establishing the application fees and time frames. Effective September 1, 2021, A.A.C. R4-26-108 Fees and Charges at (B) for psychologists and also R4-26-402. Fees and Charges at (B) for behavior analysts establish that "Under the specific authority provided by A.R.S. § 36-3606(A)(3), the Board establishes and shall collect the following fee to register as an out-of-state health care provider of telehealth services: \$600." The revenue (90%) collected from these fees will fund the costs of implementing and operating the Registry that are outlined below.
