1. CALL TO ORDER

The regular session of the Arizona Board of Psychologist Examiners Complaint Screening Committee was called to order by Chairman Bohanske at 8:34 a.m. on June 13, 2018.

3. CASE DISCUSSION/DECISION

a. Michael Rabara, Psy.D., Complaint No. 17-05

Dr. Flowers summarized the case, including salient points of the investigation and pertinent records. The Complainant was present and requested that the patient's stepfather, R.M. make a statement. The Complainant and the patient's legal counsel, Jason Kinsman, presented the evaluation report of patient that was authored by Dr. Rabara and other documentation to the Committee. The Licensee's attorney, Faren Akins, addressed the Board objecting to the submitted documentation. After deliberation, it was the consensus of the Committee to table this matter to a future meeting in order to seek advisement from the Board's Assistant Attorney General.

b. James Hardt, Complaint No. T-17-30

Dr. Flowers summarized the case, including salient points of the investigation and pertinent records. The Complaint was submitted anonymously and the respondent was not present. After deliberation, Dr. Flowers made a motion, seconded by Dr. Bohanske, to direct Board staff to contact Mr. Hardt and request that he revise his website to discontinue the use of the word psychologist or any derivative of the root word “psycho”. Upon confirmation that Mr. Hardt’s website has been revised the Complaint will be dismissed. The motion carried unanimously (2-0), by a voice vote.

c. Paulette Selmi, Ph.D., Complaint No. 17-32

Dr. Bohanske summarized the case, including salient points of the investigation and pertinent records. The Complainant was present, requested to speak and made a statement. Dr. Selmi was not present but her legal counsel, Mark Harrison, was present, requested to speak, made a statement and answered Committee members’ questions. After deliberation, Dr. Flowers made a motion, seconded by Dr. Bohanske to dismiss this matter as there are no violations of rule or statute. The motion carried unanimously (2-0), by a voice vote.

d. Phillip Lett, Ph.D., Complaint No. 17-33

Dr. Bohanske summarized the case, including salient points of the investigation and pertinent records. The Complainant was present, requested to speak and made a statement. Dr. Lett was not present but his legal counsel, Faren Akins, was present, requested to speak, made a statement and answered Committee members’ questions. After deliberation, Dr. Flowers made a motion, seconded by Dr. Bohanske to dismiss this matter as there are no violations of rule or statute. The motion carried unanimously (2-0), by a voice vote.

4. ADJOURN

There being no further business to come before the Committee, Dr. Flowers made a motion, seconded by Dr. Bohanske, to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried (2-0) and the meeting was adjourned at 9:46 a.m.
