1. CALL TO ORDER

The regular session of the Arizona Board of Psychologist Examiners Complaint Screening Committee was called to order by Chairman DiBacco, at 8:30 a.m. on July 16, 2014.

3. Regular Session – June 11, 2014

Ms. Shreeve made a motion, seconded by Dr. DiBacco, to approve the June 11, 2014 Regular Session minutes as drafted. The motion carried 2-0-1 by a voice vote, with Dr. Bohanske abstained.

4. CASE DISCUSSION/DECISION

a) Grace Jasin, Ph.D., RFI 14-11

Ms. Shreeve summarized the case, including salient points of the investigation and pertinent records. The Licensee was present and was represented by legal counsel, Mr. Larry Cohen. Mr.

Cohen made a brief statement and Licensee answered Committee members' questions. The Complainant was not present. After deliberation, Dr. Bohanske made a motion, seconded by Ms. Shreeve, to dismiss the case. The motion carried unanimously (3-0), by a voice vote.

b) **Carol McLean, Ph.D., RFI 14-18**

Dr. DiBacco summarized the case, including salient points of the investigation and pertinent records. The Licensee was present and was represented by legal counsel, Mr. Faren Akins. The Licensee requested to speak, and made a brief statement, and answered Committee members' questions. The Complainant's husband was present, requested to speak, made a brief statement, and answered Committee members' questions. After deliberation, Ms. Shreeve made a motion, seconded by Dr. DiBacco, to dismiss the case. The motion carried unanimously (3-0), by a voice vote.

c) **Martin Gangle, RFI T-14-12**

Ms. Shreeve summarized the case, including salient points of the investigation and pertinent records. The Respondent was not present. After deliberation, the Committee members voted to forward this case to the full Board for review, discussion and decision. Dr. DiBacco made a motion, seconded by Ms. Shreeve, to forward the case to the full Board for a possible violation of A.R.S. §32-2084. The motion carried unanimously (3-0), by a voice vote.

d) **Chris Wylie E.D., RFI T-14-13**

Dr. DiBacco summarized the case, including salient points of the investigation and pertinent records. The Respondent was not present. After deliberation, the Committee members voted to request billing/payment records associated with the evaluation completed by Respondent and to forward this case to the full Board for review, discussion and decision. Ms. Shreeve made a motion, seconded by Dr. Bohanske, to forward the case to the full Board for possible violations of A.R.S. §32-2084 and A.R.S. §32-2075(A)(1), for possibly practicing outside of the scope of exemption as a school psychologist. The motion carried unanimously (3-0), by a voice vote.

e) **Norman Bertel, Ph.D., RFI 14-15**

Dr. Bohanske summarized the case, including salient points of the investigation and pertinent records. The Complainant was present, requested to speak, and answered Committee members' questions. The Licensee was present, requested to speak, made a brief statement, and answered Committee members' questions. After deliberation, Dr. Bohanske made a motion, seconded by Ms. Shreeve, to dismiss the case. The motion carried unanimously (3-0), by a voice vote.

5. ADJOURN

There being no further business to come before the Committee, Dr. Bohanske made a motion, seconded by Ms. Shreeve, to adjourn the meeting. The motion carried (3-0) and the meeting was adjourned at 11:22 a.m.
