##### **A. Requesting Approval to Sit for Examination (EPPP) & Licensure**

The Committee made a formal request for additional information including a new verification of continuous preinternship hours at this location that meets requirements.

If in fact the answer was a typo, it was the consensus of the Committee to forward the application to the Board for approval to sit for the EPPP and licensure upon a passing score.
