

1 witnesses. Applicant irrevocably waives her right to such a hearing.

2 8. Applicant irrevocably waives any right to rehearing or review or to any judicial
3 review or any other appeal of this matter.

4 9. This Consent Agreement shall be subject to the approval by the Board and shall
5 be effective only when signed by the Executive Director and accepted by the Board. In the
6 event that the Board does not approve this Consent Agreement, it is withdrawn and shall be of
7 no evidentiary value and shall not be relied upon nor introduced in any action by any party,
8 except that the parties agree that should the Board reject this Consent Agreement and this case
9 proceeds to hearing, Applicant shall assert no claim that the Board was prejudiced by its review
10 and discussion of this document or any records relating thereto.

11 10. The Consent Agreement, once approved by the Board and signed by the
12 Applicant and Executive Director, shall constitute a public record which may be disseminated
13 as a formal action of the Board.

15 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

16 11. The Board is the duly constituted authority for licensing and regulating the
17 practice of psychology and behavior analysis in the State of Arizona.

18 12. Applicant has submitted an application for licensure as a psychologist in the
19 State of Arizona.
20

21 13. On February 1, 2016, the Board office received Applicant's application for
22 licensure by waiver (dated January 26, 2016).
23

24 14. On March 8, 2016, the Board office received information that Applicant did not
25 disclose her criminal history on the initial application. On March 10, 2016, Applicant was sent
26 a letter asking her to address her non-disclosure, details of her criminal history and her use of
27 the term "psychologist" on a dating website. On May 10, 2016, the Board received Applicant's
28 response.

15. On June 6, 2016, the Board's Application Review Committee (Committee)

1 reviewed Applicant's application in its entirety. The Committee voted to forward her
2 application to the Board for further review.

3 16. On August 12, 2016, the Board reviewed the application and noted that
4 Applicant received traffic violations (related to driving under the influence) on June 15, 2015,
5 and January 25, 2016, and a traffic violation on September 22, 2015.

7 17. The Board noted that Applicant answered "no" to question #20 of the
8 application:

9 *Are you currently awaiting trial, under indictment, have been convicted of, pled*
10 *no contest or guilty to any felony or a misdemeanor other than a minor traffic*
11 *offense (a DUI is not a minor traffic offense) or ever entered into a diversion*
12 *program instead of prosecution, including any convictions that have been*
13 *expunged, pardoned or deleted? (If yes, please include in your explanation the*
14 *status of resolution, and expected resolution date)*

15 18. On September 14, 2016, the Board and Applicant entered into an Interim
16 Consent Agreement and Order for Fitness for Duty Examinations. Additionally, the Board
17 issued a third additional information request regarding her references, criminal history, work
18 history, and preinternship experience. Dr. Goldfine complied with the Interim Consent
19 Agreement and Order for Fitness for Duty Examinations and submitted the requested
20 information.

21 19. On October 6, 2017, the Board met and reviewed Dr. Goldfine's application,
22 subsequent information and her Fitness for Duty Reports.

23 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

24 20. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-2081(Q) – If the board finds that it can take rehabilitative
25 or disciplinary action at any time during the investigative or disciplinary process, it may enter
26 into a consent agreement with the psychologist to limit or restrict the psychologist's practice or
27 to rehabilitate the psychologist in order to protect the public and ensure the psychologist's
28 ability to safely engage in the practice of psychology. The board may also require the
psychologist to successfully complete a board approved rehabilitative, retraining or assessment

1 program at the psychologist's expense.

3 **ORDER FOR PROBATION, SUPERVISION, CONTINUING EDUCATION AND**
4 **REHABILITATION**
5

6 21. **ISSUANCE OF LICENSE:** Upon Applicant's acceptance of this Consent
7 Agreement, as evidenced by her signature, and approved by the Board, as evidenced by the
8 Executive Director's signature, and upon receipt of the pro-rated license fee, the Board shall
9 issue Applicant a license to practice psychology in the State of Arizona, in accordance with this
10 Consent Agreement.

11 22. **PROBATION:** Beginning the date of licensure, Applicant's license shall be
12 placed on probation for a period of twenty four (24) months. Applicant may petition the Board
13 to be released from probation after twelve (12) months. If the Applicant petitions the Board to
14 be released from probation after twelve (12) months and before the Board grants the request,
15 the Board shall determine whether Applicant is in compliance with the terms of the Consent
16 Agreement and whether the conduct that lead to this Consent Agreement has been remediated
17 satisfactorily.

18 23. **SUPERVISION:** Upon gaining employment or engaging in the private practice
19 of psychology, Applicant shall notify the Board in writing of her employment status, including
20 the place of employment, her position/title and the total hours worked each week. Further, upon
21 gaining employment or engaging in the private practice of psychology, Applicant shall receive
22 at least two (2) hours of individual face-to-face supervision for every twenty (20) hours worked
23 for a minimum of six (6) months. After six (6) months, and upon the recommendation of the
24 supervisor and approval by the Board, the supervision may be decreased to one (1) hour of
25 individual face-to-face supervision for every twenty (20) hours worked for the duration of the
26 probation. Applicant shall present this Consent Agreement to any potential employers. The
27 supervisor must be a licensed psychologist in the State of Arizona.

28 24. The supervisor shall submit to the Board quarterly reports summarizing Applicant's
supervision. The Supervisor shall submit to the Board a final report at the conclusion of the
supervision. Upon starting supervision, Applicant shall notify the Board office in writing and

1 work with the Executive Director to determine when the supervision reports will be due.

2 25. **CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENT:** Prior to the termination of
3 probation, Applicant shall complete and receive a passing grade in a three (3) semester hour, or
4 equivalent, graduate level ethics in psychology course. Within three (3) weeks of completion
5 of the ethics course, Applicant shall submit evidence to the Board that she received a passing
6 grade.

7 26. **BIOLOGICAL FLUID COLLECTION:** Upon licensure, Applicant shall
8 contact TASC, Inc. and make arrangements to undergo random biological fluid collection
9 twice monthly for no less than three (3) months. Applicant can contact TASC at:

16 During all times that Applicant is physically present in the State of Arizona, Applicant shall
17 promptly comply with requests from TASC staff to submit to biological fluid collection.
18 Applicant shall follow TASC's guidelines during the required three (3) month duration of
19 biological fluid collection. The collection may be witnessed. Applicant shall arrange with
20 TASC to have any and all biological fluid collection results sent directly to the Board office.
21 Testing positive for substances not appropriately prescribed by a physician to Applicant shall
22 be considered a violation of the Consent Agreement and may subject Applicant to further
23 disciplinary proceedings.

24 27. **COMPLETION OF TERMS:** Upon completion of her probation, supervision,
25 education requirements and biological fluid collection requirements. Applicant shall petition
26 the Board in writing for permission to be released from the terms of the Consent Agreement.
27 Applicant shall not be released from the terms and conditions of this Consent Agreement until
28 such time she demonstrates her full compliance with the same to the Board's satisfaction.

 28. **TOLLING FOR PERIODS OF NON-PRACTICE:** If, for any reason,
Licensee ceases practicing psychology in Arizona for more than 30 days or leaves Arizona to

1 reside or practice psychology outside Arizona, the periods of temporary or permanent residency
2 or practice outside Arizona or the non-practice within Arizona do not apply to reduce the
3 duration of probation under this Order. License shall notify the Board in writing within five
4 days of the dates of departure and return or the dates of non-practice in Arizona.

5 29. **EFFECTIVE DATE:** Applicant understands that the foregoing Consent
6 Agreement shall not become effective unless and until adopted by the Board of Psychologist
7 Examiners and executed on behalf of the Board. Any modification to this original document is
8 ineffective and void unless mutually approved by the parties in writing.

9 30. **CONSIDERATION IN FUTURE ACTIONS:** Applicant understands that this
10 Consent Agreement, or any part thereof, may be considered in any future disciplinary action
11 against her.

12 31. **FINAL RESOLUTION:** This Consent Agreement constitutes a final resolution
13 of this matter but does not constitute a dismissal or resolution of other matters currently
14 pending before the Board, if any, and does not constitute any waiver, expressed or implied, of
15 the Board's statutory authority or jurisdiction regarding any other pending or future
16 investigations, actions or proceedings. Further, this Consent Agreement does not preclude any
17 other agency, subdivision or officer of this State from instituting other civil or criminal
18 proceedings with respect to the conduct that is the subject of this Consent Agreement.

19 32. **TIME:** Time is of the essence with regard to this Consent Agreement.

20 33. **COSTS:** The Applicant shall be responsible for all costs incurred as a result of
21 her compliance with this Consent Agreement.

22 34. **NON-COMPLIANCE:** If Applicant fails to comply with the terms of this
23 Consent Agreement, the Board shall properly institute proceedings for noncompliance with this
24 Consent Agreement, which may result in disciplinary and/or remedial actions. Violation of this
25 Consent Agreement is a violation of A.R.S. § 32-2061(16)(aa), which is "violating a formal
26 board order, consent agreement, term of probation or stipulated agreement."

27 35. **PUBLIC RECORD:** This Consent Agreement is a public record that may be
28 publicly disseminated as a formal action of the Board.






