FINDINGS OF FACT

8. On June 5, 1992, Licensee obtained a license to practice psychology from the State Board of Psychology of Ohio ("Ohio Board") as License No. 4527.

9. On or about November 1, 2004, the Ohio Board notified Licensee that a complaint had been filed against him.

10. In July, 2005, Dr. Biggs applied for licensure with the Arizona State Board of Psychologist Examiners ("Arizona Board").

11. In August, 2005, Dr. Biggs was granted a licensure to practice psychology in Arizona as License No. 3734.

12. On or about October, 2006, Dr. Biggs was notified by the Ohio Board that it intended to investigate the complaint that had been filed on or about November 1, 2004.

13. In September, 2005, Licensee relocated to Arizona from Ohio.

14. On or about February 24, 2006, Licensee signed a Consent Agreement with the Ohio Board in which Licensee agreed to a five (5) year restriction from providing psychological work supervision or psychological training supervision.

15. On September 30, 2006, Licensee allowed his license with the Ohio Board to expire.

16. On December 5, 2006, the Arizona Board received a self report from Licensee concerning the Ohio Board's disciplinary actions.

1 17. On December 12, 2006, the Arizona Board opened a complaint against Licensee based
2 on Licensee's self report concerning the Ohio Board's disciplinary actions (Case No. 06-44).

3 18. During the Arizona Board's investigation of Case 06-44, it was discovered that there
4 were a number of inconsistencies in Licensee's Application for Licensure with the Arizona Board
5 regarding a civil action filed against Licensee in Ohio.

6 **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

7 19. The conduct and circumstances described above constitute unprofessional conduct
8 pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-2061(A)(13)(j) - Making a fraudulent or untrue statement to the Board or its
9 investigators, staff or consultants.

10 20. The conduct and circumstances described above constitute unprofessional conduct
11 pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-2061(A)(13)(n) - Unprofessional conduct in another jurisdiction that resulted
12 in censure, probation, or a civil penalty or in the denial, suspension, restriction or revocation of a
13 certificate or license to practice as a psychologist.

14 **ORDER FOR DECREE OF CENSURE AND RESTRICTION OF LICENSE**

15 Based upon the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law, the parties agree as follows:

16 1. Licensee is hereby issued a **Decree of Censure** regarding the violation of A.R.S. § 32-
17 2061(A)(13)(j).

18 2. Licensee agrees to a four (4) year and five (5) month restriction from providing
19 psychological work supervision or psychological training supervision under his license to practice
20 psychology in Arizona. The duration of this restriction gives Licensee credit for the seven (7) months
21 of the five (5) year Ohio restriction which he served before his Ohio license expired.
