CONSENT AGREEMENT AND  
ORDER OF REVOCATION

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-2081(K)(1) and 41-1092.07(F)(5), the Arizona Board of Psychologist Examiners ("Board") and Steven William Henderson, Ph.D. ("Respondent"), holder of license number 3250 for the practice of psychology, agree as follows:

CONSENT AGREEMENT

1. The Board and Respondent enter into this Consent Agreement in order to resolve this case promptly, judiciously, and consistent with the public interest and the statutory requirements of the Board.

2. Respondent enters into this Consent Agreement for the purpose of this Board proceeding only and this shall not be construed as evidence of a violation for any other proceeding.

3. Respondent makes this agreement freely and voluntarily.

4. Respondent has had the opportunity to consult with an attorney prior to entering into this Consent Agreement.

5. Respondent has read and understands this Consent Agreement and the effect of revocation of his license to practice psychology in the State of Arizona.

6. By signing this Consent Agreement, Respondent is irrevocably waiving his right to a hearing, rehearing, or judicial review.



Respondent understands that this Consent Agreement shall not become effective unless and until it is signed by Respondent and is adopted by the Board and signed by its Executive Director, Maxine McCarthy. If the Board rejects the Consent Agreement and this matter proceeds to formal hearing, Respondent will assert no claim that the Board was prejudiced by its review and discussion of this Consent Agreement and Order of Revocation, nor will this Consent Agreement be used as evidence in any formal hearing.

1 8. The conduct and circumstances regarding the criminal conviction of Respondent in Maricopa  
2 County Superior Court Case No. CR2005-137156 constitute grounds for the revocation of license number  
3 3250 pursuant to A.R.S. § 32-2061 *et.seq.*

4 9. This Consent Agreement and Order of Revocation is a public record.


