3. CASE DISCUSSION/DECISION

a.) John DenBoer, Ph.D., RFI 10-06

The complainant was present via telephone, requested to speak and made a brief statement. The licensee was present, via telephone, and was represented by council, Larry Cohen who requested to speak and made a brief statement. Mr. Larson asked Jeanne Galvin whether or not the committee has jurisdiction in this matter wherein Ms. Galvin responded. Mr. Larson made a motion, seconded by Dr. Brundage to dismiss this matter for lack of jurisdiction. The motion carried (2-0).

b.) Steven M. Savlov, Ph.D. RFI 10-05

The complainant was present via telephone, requested to speak and made a brief statement. Dr. Brundage summarized the case, including salient points of investigation and pertinent records. The Licensee was not present but was represented by council, Peter Fischer, who was present, requested to speak and made a brief statement. After deliberation, Committee members found no evidence of violation of statute or rule by the licensee. Dr. Brundage made a motion, seconded by Mr. Larson, to dismiss the case. The motion carried (2-0)

c.) Kimi Wright, Ph.D. RFI 10-14

Mr. Larson summarized the case, including salient points of investigation and pertinent records. The complainant was present, requested to speak and made a brief statement. The licensee was present and was represented by council, Debra Hill, who requested to speak and made a brief statement. After deliberation, Committee members found no evidence of violation of statute or rule by the licensee. Mr. Larson made a motion, seconded by Dr. Brundage, to dismiss the case. The motion carried (2-0).

d.) Young B. Lee, Ph.D. RFI 10-11

Mr. Larson summarized the case, including salient points of investigation and pertinent records. The complainant was not present. The licensee was present and was represented by council, Mark Harrison, who requested to speak and made a brief statement. After deliberation, Mr. Larson made a motion, seconded by Dr. Brundage to refer this case to the full Board for further review and investigation for possible violations of A.R.S. §32-2061(13)(h) for possible failure to maintain and retain adequate business, financial or professional records pertaining to the psychological services provided to a client and A.R.S. §32-2061(13)(o) for possibly falling below the current standards of practice. The motion carried (2-0).

e.) Ashley B. Hart, Ph.D. RFI 10-15

Dr. Brundage summarized the case, including salient points of investigation and pertinent records. Neither the complainant nor the licensee were present. After deliberation, Committee members found no evidence of violation of statute or rule by the licensee. Mr. Larson made a motion, seconded by Dr. Brundage, to dismiss the case. The motion carried (2-0).

5. ADJOURN

There being no further business to come before the Committee, a motion to adjourn was made by Mr. Larson, seconded by Dr. Brundage, and unanimously carried 2-0. The meeting was adjourned at 9:50 a.m.
