3. DISCUSSION DECISION REGARDING APPROVAL OF ARC MINUTES

• Regular Session Minutes-July 3, 2012

Regular session minutes from the July 3, 2012, Application Review Committee Meeting were considered for approval. Dr. Brundage made a motion, seconded by Dr. Wechsler to approve the minutes as drafted. Motion carried 2-0.

4. DISCUSSION DECISION REGARDING APPROVAL OF PSYCHOLOGY APPLICANTS

Requesting Approval to sit for Examination (EPPP) & Licensure

Kathleen Brennan-Glynn, Ph.D. – Committee members proceeded with a substantive review of Dr. Brennan-Glynn's application and subsequent materials. Upon review, the Committee noted that the materials submitted were complete and fulfilled the requirements of statutes and rules. It was the consensus of the Committee to move Dr. Brennan-Glynn's application to the full Board

for approval to take the EPPP and licensure upon a passing score and payment of the pro-rated licensure fee.

Dr. Wechsler made a motion, seconded by Dr. Brundage, to forward the application of Kathleen Brennan-Glynn, Ph.D., to the full Board for review and approval to take the EPPP and licensure upon a passing score and payment of the pro-rated licensure fee

Joseph Carmona, Ph.D. – Committee members proceeded with a substantive review of Dr. Carmona’s application. Upon review, the Committee noted that the materials submitted were complete and fulfilled the requirements of statutes and rules. It was the consensus of the Committee to move Dr. Carmona’s application to the full Board for approval to take the EPPP and licensure upon a passing score and payment of the pro-rated licensure fee.

It was the consensus of the Committee to move Dr. Gulley’s application to the full Board for approval to take the EPPP and licensure upon a passing score and payment of the pro-rated licensure fee.

Rose Marie Nunez, Psy.D. – Committee members proceeded with a substantive review of Dr. Nunez’s application. Upon review, the Committee noted that the materials submitted were complete and fulfilled the requirements of statutes and rules. Vahe Sarkissian, Ph.D. – Committee members proceeded with a substantive review of Dr. Sarkissian’s application. Upon review, the Committee noted that the materials submitted were complete and fulfilled the requirements of statutes and rules. It was the consensus of the

Committee to move Dr. Sarkissian's application to the full Board for approval to take the EPPP and licensure upon a passing score and payment of the pro-rated licensure fee.

Dr. Wechsler made a motion, seconded by Dr. Brundage, to forward the applications of Kathleen Brennan-Glynn, Ph.D., Joseph Carmona, Ph.D., Lori Gulley, Psy.D., Rose Marie Nunez, Psy.D. Fabia Gomez-Salas, Psy.D., Cindy Miller, Ph.D. and Vahe Sarkissian, Ph.D. to the full Board for review and approval to take the EPPP and licensure upon a passing score and payment of the pro-rated licensure fee, and to forward the application of Amanda Reed, Ph.D., to the full Board for review and approval to take the EPPP and licensure upon a passing score and payment of the pro-rated licensure fee upon receipt of her official transcript reflecting her degree and to forward Morgan Francis, Psy.D. to the full Board for lack of a quorum. The motion carried (2-0).

Requesting Approval to Sit for Examination (EPPP) Only

Kathleen Lanflisi, Ph.D. – Committee members proceeded with a substantive review of Dr. Lanflisi's application. Upon review, the Committee noted that the materials submitted were complete and fulfilled the requirements of statutes and rules. It was the consensus of the Committee to move Dr. Lanflisi's application to the full Board for approval to take the EPPP.

Benjamin Richter, Psy.D. – Committee members proceeded with a substantive review of Dr. Richter's application. Upon review of Dr. Richter's Core Program Requirements, the Committee noted that he completed 3 quarter credit hours in Mental Health Law. The Committee noted that Dr. Richter obtained 3 quarter credit hours in Professional Issues and Ethics and 1.5 quarter credit hours in Advanced Professional Development and Ethics totaling 4.5 quarter hour, which is 0.5 quarter hours deficient. Dr. Richter also indicated Mental Health Law (psyc 1708) as a course in this category. The Committee is requesting that Dr. Richter provide an explanation of how Mental Health Law meets the statutory requirement and to provide his syllabus for Mental Health Law in order to determine whether the course meets the statutory requirement for ethics pursuant to A.R.S. §32-2071(4)(a):

Roswitha Saenz, Ph.D. – Committee members proceeded with a substantive review of Dr. Saenz's application. Upon review, the Committee noted that the materials submitted were complete and fulfilled the requirements of statutes and rules. It was the consensus of the Committee to move Dr. Saenz's application to the full Board for approval to take the EPPP.

Dr. Brundage made a motion, seconded by Dr. Wechsler, to forward the applications of Kathleen Lanflisi, Ph.D. and Roswitha Saenz, Ph.D to the full Board for approval to sit for the EPPP and to issue Benjamin Richter, Psy.D. a RAID letter regarding the deficiencies discussed in his application. Dancho, resides in a different state than Ms. Irwin. The Committee is requesting clarification regarding how Ms. Irwin was observed while obtaining supervision, at a minimum, of once every two weeks with Ms. Dancho during her supervised work experience or independent field work. In addition, the Committee is requesting clarification regarding how Ms. Irwin obtained direct one-to-one contact with Ms. Dancho during her supervised work experience or independent field work. The Committee is requesting clarification that Ms. Irwin's supervised work experience or independent field work meets the requirement of A.R.S. §32-2091.01(A)(2) and A.R.S. §32-2091.03(D).

Christina Whalen, Ph.D., BCBA – Committee members proceeded with a substantive review of Dr. Whalen’s application. Upon review, the Committee noted that the materials submitted were complete and fulfilled the requirements of statutes and rules. It was the consensus of the Committee to move Ms. Whalen’s application to the full Board for review and approval of licensure upon receipt of the pro-rated licensure fee.

Brian Van Meerten, M.Ed., BCBA – Committee members proceeded with a substantive review of Mr. Van Meerten’s application. Upon review, the Committee noted that Mr. Van Meerten completed question number 22 of the application incorrectly otherwise the materials submitted were complete and fulfilled the requirements of statutes and rules. It was the consensus of the Committee to move Mr. Van Meerten’s application to the full Board for review and approval of licensure upon receipt of the pro-rated licensure fee pending the receipt of the correction of question number 22 of the application.
