**3. APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Minutes from the December 9, 2009 and January 13, 2010 Complaint Screening Committee Meetings were considered for approval. Mr. Donaldson made a motion, seconded by Dr. Karp to approve the minutes. Motion carried (2-1) with Dr. Wiggins abstained.

**4. CASE DISCUSSION/DECISION**

**a.) Patricia Kerstner, Ph.D. RFI 09-47**

Dr. Wiggins recused from this case. The complainant was not present. The licensee was present, and was represented by counsel, Susan Trujillo. Mr. Donaldson summarized the case, including salient points of investigation and pertinent records. Both the licensee and her counsel requested to speak and made a brief statement.
