1. CALL TO ORDER

The regular session of the Arizona Board of Psychologist Examiners Complaint Screening Committee was called to order by Chairman Donaldson, at 8:30 a.m. on August 14, 2013. One executive session was held.

3. CASE DISCUSSION/DECISION

a) Rob Morgan, Psy.D., RFI 13-13

Dr. Brundage summarized the case initiated by the Board, including salient points of investigation and pertinent records. The Licensee was not present nor represented by legal counsel. After deliberation, Dr. Wechsler made a motion, seconded by Dr. Brundage to refer this case to the full Board for further review and investigation for possible violations of A.R.S §32-3208 (A) for possibly

failing to notify the Board within 10 working days after a misdemeanor charge was filed against him. The motion unanimously carried (3-0), by voice vote.

b) Rebecca Burden, M.S., CCC-SLP, BCBA, RFI BA-13-01

Dr. Wechsler summarized the case, including salient points of investigation and pertinent records. The Licensee was present (telephonically) and was not represented by legal counsel. Ms. Burden requested to speak, made a statement, and answered Committee members' questions. After deliberation, Mr. Donaldson made a motion, seconded by Dr. Wechsler, and unanimously carried (3-0), by voice vote, to move into Executive Session, to obtain confidential legal advice from the Board's attorney. The Committee members went into Executive Session at 9:02 a.m. and resumed open session at 9:08 a.m.

Upon returning to open session, Dr. Wechsler made a motion to refer this case to the full Board for further review and investigation. The Committee members' requested more information regarding the Respondents supervision and requested her supervisor's presence at the full Board meeting. The motion unanimously carried (3-0), by a roll call vote.

c) Anonymous Complaint

Ms. Martin summarized the case, no specific Licensee was identified and Complainant did not provide sufficient information to elicit a response from Licensee. Dr. Brundage made a motion, seconded by Dr. Wechsler, not to open an investigation because there was insufficient information. The motion carried unanimously (3-0), by a voice vote.

4. ADJOURN

There being no further business to come before the Committee, a motion to adjourn was made by Dr. Brundage, seconded by Dr. Wechsler, and unanimously carried (3-0), by a voice vote. The meeting adjourned at 9:23 a.m.
