c.) Katrina Buwalda, Psy.D., RFI 11-14

Mr. Donaldson made a motion, seconded by Dr. Karp, to move into executive session at 9:47 a.m. to obtain confidential legal advice, public session resumed at 9:51 a.m. The complainant was present, made a statement and answered Committee members' questions.
